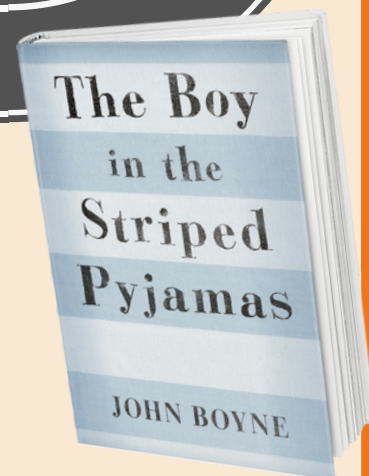




Year 7 English LTP



Autumn 1

Topic: Novel Study (Modern Text: *The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas*)

Why it's taught: Develop empathy, inference, and understanding of character and theme. Encourage wider reading and exploration of moral/social issues.



Autumn 2

Topic: Poetry Across Time

Why it's taught: Introduces pupils to a range of poetic forms and devices. Builds analytical skills and supports creative writing through imitation and response.



Spring 1

Topic: Shakespeare (e.g., *A Midsummer Night's Dream*)

Why it's taught: Provides access to literary heritage. Develops understanding of language, performance and Elizabethan context, building cultural capital.



Spring 2

Topic: Non-Fiction & Media Texts (Articles, Speeches, Adverts)

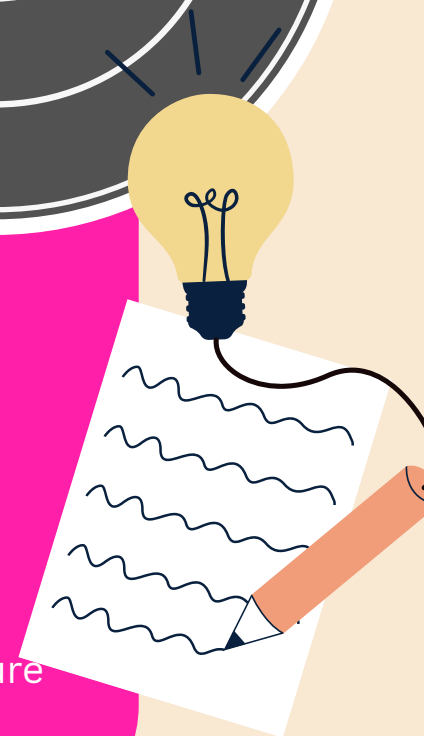
Why it's taught: Strengthens ability to read critically, compare viewpoints, and identify bias. Supports transactional writing skills such as letters, speeches and persuasive articles.



Summer 1

Topic: Creative Writing (Descriptive & Narrative)

Why it's taught: Encourages imagination, vocabulary development, and writing stamina. Teaches grammar, sentence variety, and structure through storytelling.



Summer 2

Topic: Drama Text

Why it's taught: Builds confidence in spoken language, performance and collaboration. Strengthens interpretation skills and promotes discussion of social themes.
